AVAILABLE WORKSHOPS

CONTEMPORARY TECHNIQUE CLASS

This class contains a strong focus on:

- · establishing correct alignment through movement and stillness
- · developing awareness of one's centre of gravity
- embodying a grounded and fluid approach to movement sequences

COMPOSITION WORKSHOP

Tailored around the VCE Composition Solo Assessment, this workshop provides students the necessary tools to feel confident in the creation of their own choreography.

Students will:

- gain an understanding of how to challenge themselves when trying to expand to their movement vocabulary
- learn how to find variation in form and movement quality through guided tasks led by the facilitator
- enhance their skills in delivering an intention through their individual compositions

IMPROVISATION WORKSHOP

This workshop provides students a more in depth understanding of improvisation techniques and helps them develop courage and confidence through impromptu movement.

Through guided improvisation and creative tasks, students will:

- generate new movement vocabulary
- grow knowledge for developing an improvisation toolkit to assist both choreographic process and performance skills

LEARNT WORKS FOR VCE

Students are provided the opportunity to experience repertoire from Chunky Move productions as part of their VCE Learnt Works. Students will learn choreography and engage in creative tasks used in the creation of works including *Token Armies* or *Universal Estate*.

Both Learnt Works have the potential to deepen students understanding of contemporary dance practice and will help students understand the relationship between intention and choreographic outcomes.

Minimum requirement 4x 90-minute sessions

Token Armies: Minimum 10 Dancers
Universal Estate: Minimum 2 Dancers

PRIMARY SCHOOL MOVEMENT CLASS

A fun and engaging movement class for primary groups, the session will reflect on elements of teamwork, kinaesthetic awareness, coordination and problem-solving skills as students are taken through:

- a warmup
- · movement games and tasks
- a choreographed dance sequence

PRESCHOOL / EARLY PRIMARY AGED CHILDREN MOVEMENT CLASS

This class focuses on joyful, responsive, free movements and expression offering participants a broad range of physical actions utilising mobility, strength and endurance. This structured creative experience encourages participation and collaboration, and builds coordination, muscle memory and self-esteem. Students will gain an awareness and appreciation of oneself and others through teamwork and problem-solving activities.

Duration: 20 minutes Age suitability: 4 – 8

BOOKING OPTIONS

EXCURSION

Dance workshops are held at Chunky Move's purpose-built dance studios, featuring sprung flooring, moveable mirrors and high-quality audio system. Situated in the heart of Melbourne's arts precinct, the studios are easily accessible by public transport.

INCURSION

On request, dance workshops can be held at your school. Please bear in mind that you must be able to provide a suitable space and that an extra fee may apply to cover the travel expense of the workshop facilitator.

ONLINE

For schools located beyond metropolitan Melbourne, our workshops can be delivered live via Zoom. Schools must ensure students have an appropriate space to participate in, with room to move and suitable flooring for dancing bare foot.

OUR STUDIOS

Chunky Move is located at 111 Sturt Street, Southbank VIC 3006.

Our purpose-built venue in Southbank has two studios, with sprung flooring and iconic orange panelling.

These spaces are otherwise used for company rehearsals, performances, and our public classes program.



WHEELCHAIR / FLAT ACCESS

Chunky Move is fully wheelchair accessible via a lift at the main entrance, with a wheelchair accessible bathroom.

TAKING PUBLIC TRANSPORT TO CHUNKY MOVE

If taking Public Transport, there are two tram options, both connecting with Flinders Street Station:

Take Route 1, and alight at Stop 18/Grant Street. Continue south down Sturt Street to ACCA's front door at 111 Sturt Street. If you are standing facing the ACCA front doors, you will see a courtyard on the right side of this building. Enter the courtyard and towards the end on the left of the courtyard is a large Chunky Move sign. This is our front door. Walk towards this sign.

Alternatively, take Routes 3, 5, 16, 64, 67, 72 along St Kilda Road. Alight at Stop 17/Police Memorial (accessible tram stop), cross St Kilda Road and continue down Grant Street. Walk past the big yellow sculpture and through the large undercroft. The glass door to our building is immediately on your right once you walk through the undercroft into the courtyard.
